Students who meet the basic eligibility criteria listed on the main IISc Admissions website (https://iisc.ac.in/admissions/) and are interested in the research areas mentioned above are welcome to apply. Primary research techniques in the two open labs involve conducting human behavioral psychophysics experiments, computational modeling, functional MRI (fMRI), electroencephalography (EEG), high-density muscle recordings (EMG), Transcranial Direction Current Stimulation (TDCS) and Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS).

Unlike the regular August admission cycles, there will be no rotations for students joining in this mid-year admissions cycle, and they will be directly assigned to one of the open labs.
